Homeshare brings two people together who have a lot to offer

Homeshare is a flexible arrangement where we carefully match you with a sharer who is right for you.

You contribute an affordable monthly fee to cover the running costs of the scheme

We provide a safe and supportive service with background checks, references and ongoing support.

Your sharer can provide 10 hours of support a week of help with daily living tasks such as cleaning, shopping, cooking and gardening and the reassurance of someone else at home at night.

The service does not offer personal care.
